Introduction

The BA (Honours) in English Language programme is recommended for students interested in the humanities with a concentration on the English language and language teaching, and also for those who are interested in obtaining a firm foundation for further study in English language teaching.

Programme Objectives

This programme aims at training students and enabling them to use the English language for academic and professional purposes. It will provide students with skills required for professions related to language education. The graduates are expected to have a thorough knowledge and expertise in the English language and literature, along with basic ideas of the science of language. The programme will produce efficient English language practitioners and professionals as there is a serious dearth of professionals in English in Bangladesh. Thus, the programme contributes to the advancement of English language learning and teaching in Bangladesh.
