

Info-graphic of the Scientific Documents contributed by researchers from Jagannath University in 2020

The publication rate of JnU is close to DU although there is a big difference in infrastructure/facilities between JnU and DU.

The researchers from the Jagannath University have contributed (from about 650 faculties) in only 159 documents (Data analyzed on 20.02.2021) in Scopus indexed journals, conference proceedings, book chapters, review, note and letter. In case of DU, the total documents were 763 (from about 2000 faculties)

Below is presented the info-graphic of the publications.

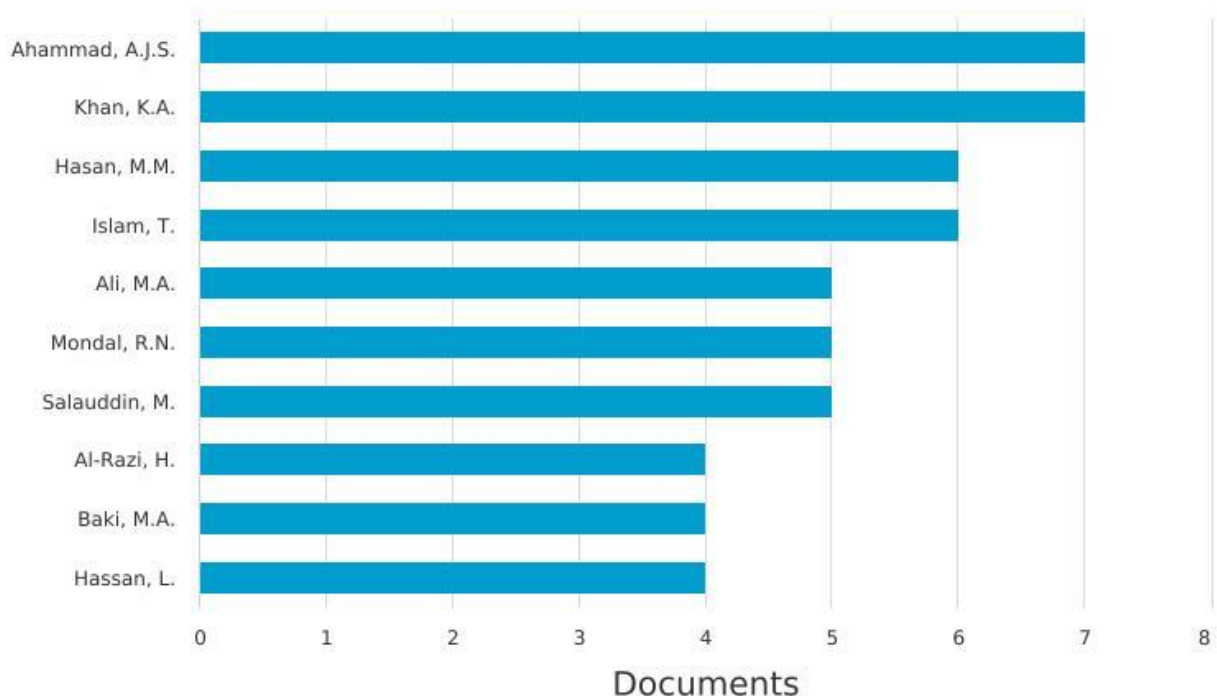
1.Top 10 researchers in terms of number of Publications

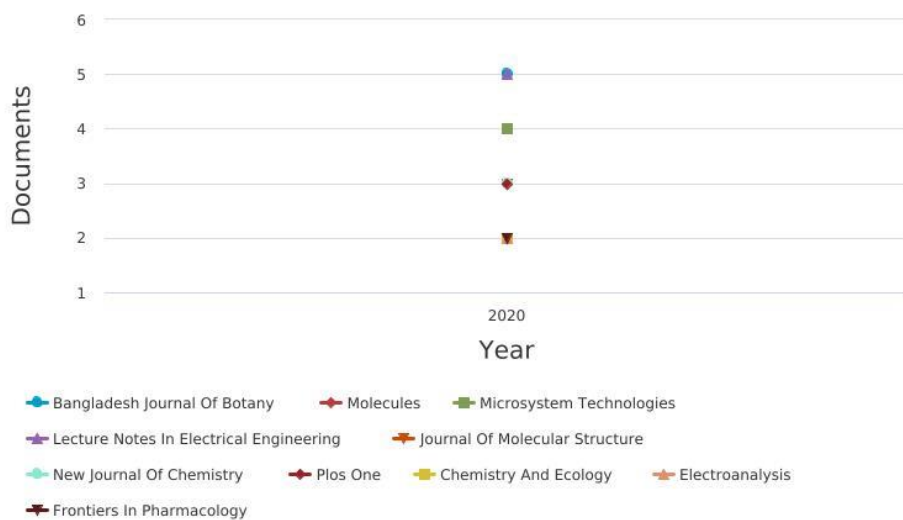
2. Top ten Journals and their CiteScores

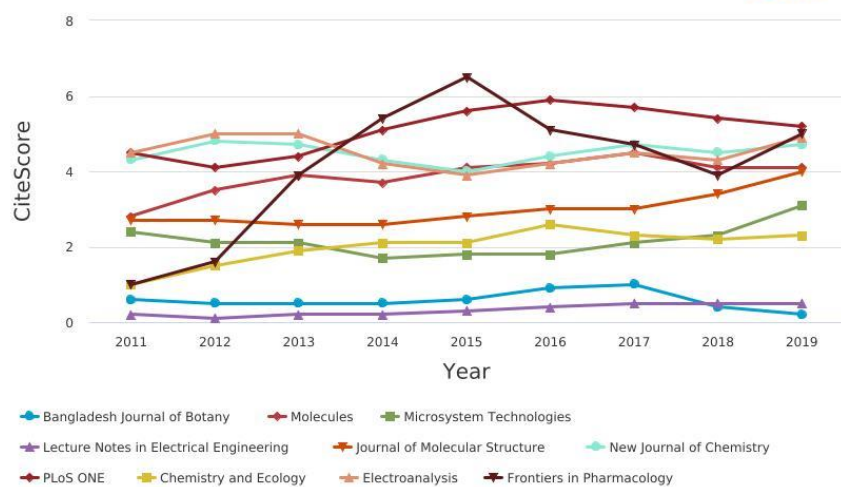

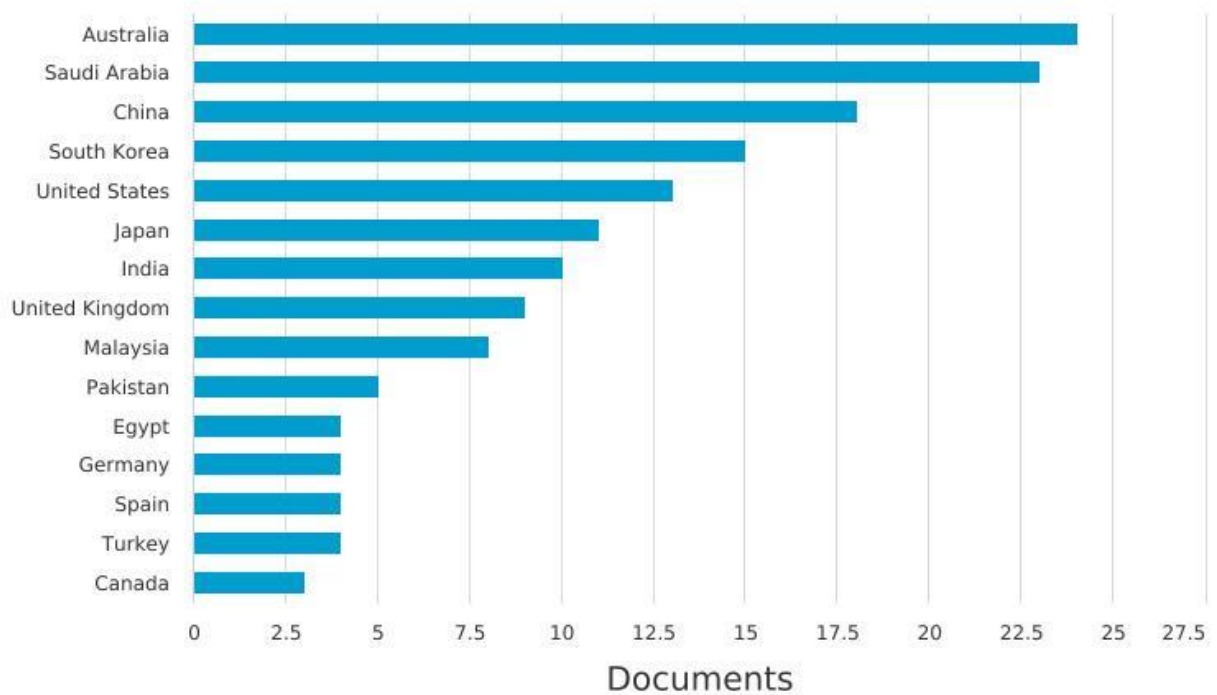
3. Top 15 countries with which JnU researchers collaborated

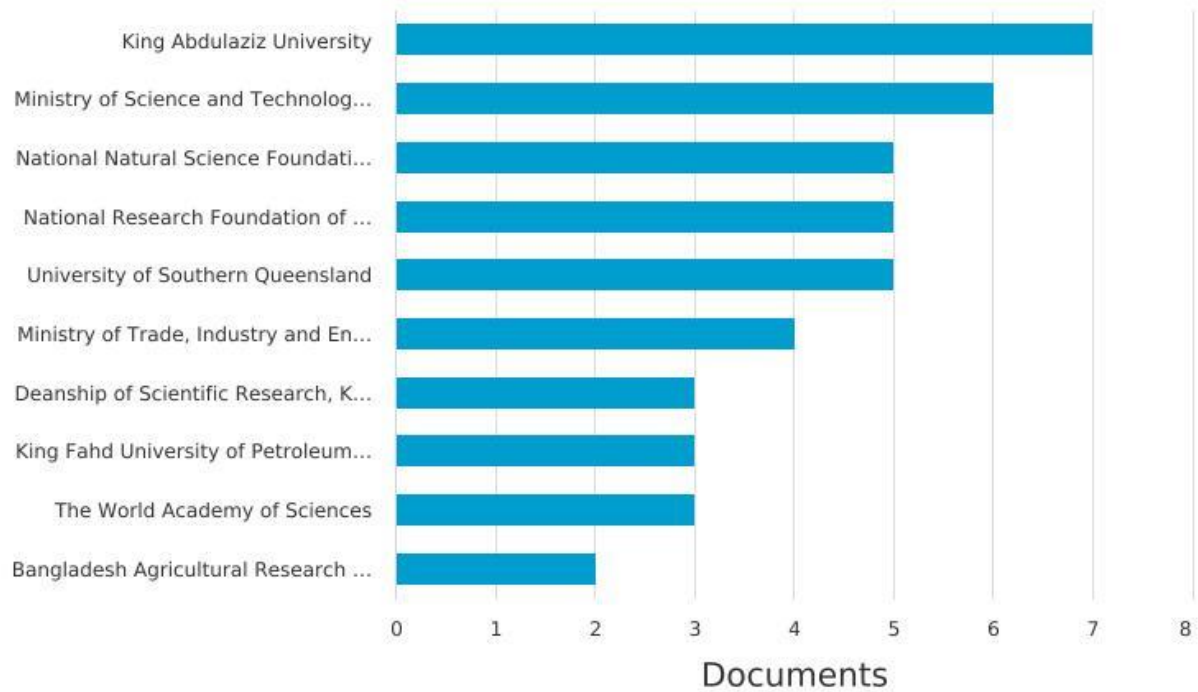

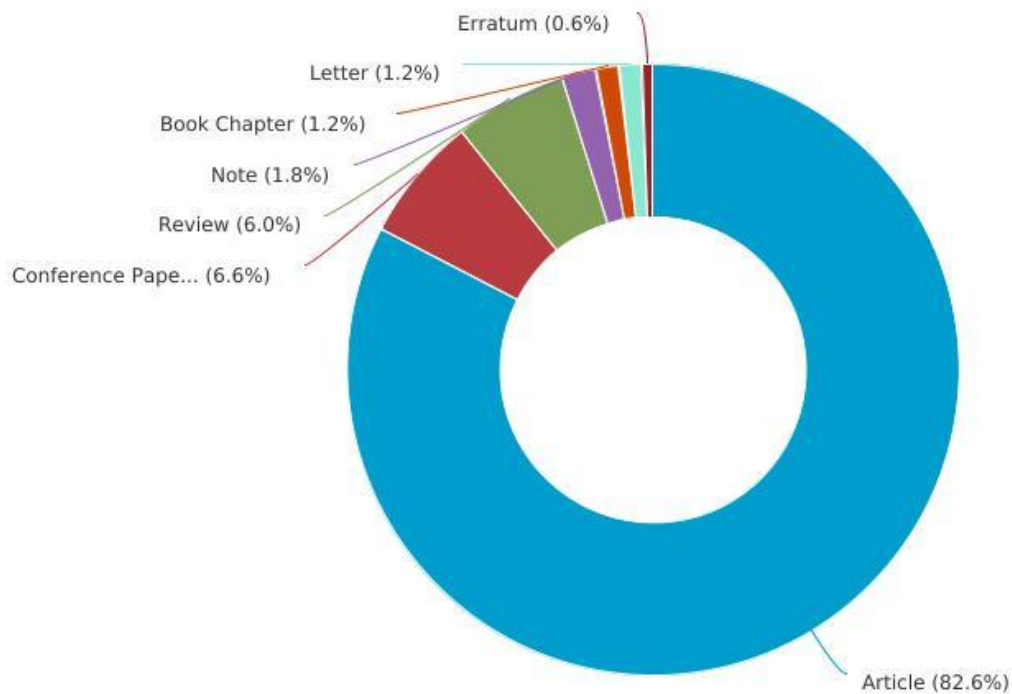

5. Top Document type

In 2020, according to the Scopus database (data collected on 20 February 2021), researchers of Jagannath University published around 159 research documents with the majority (82.6%) of them were Scopus index journal articles. 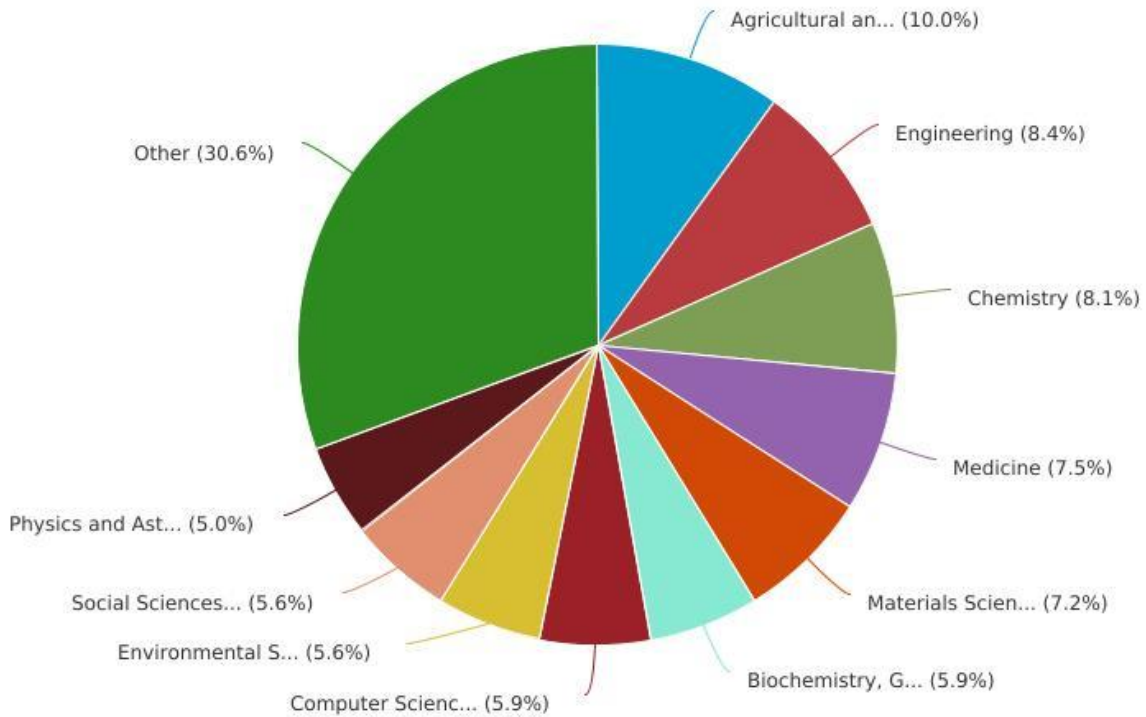
